It is thought that the first people of Japan were migrants from East Asia and South Pacific Islands. The country's first and permanent government center was established in Nara at the beginning of the 8th century. This empire reigned between 710 and 784.

In 794 a government center was established in Kyoto. This empire continued until 1192 and Kyoto became capital. Between 1333 and 1338, short-term governments were seen. In 16. century Europeans entered the territory of Japan. In this process, Christianity was intended to spread, but Japan thought it would be harmful for its own people. Therefore, all foreigners were forbidden to enter the country except the Dutch and Chinese merchants.

Today we are going to tell you about our typical breakfast. Our typical Italian breakfast is suitable for any seasons. There are different kinds of breakfast in Italy, but among the most appreciated ones we have:

Cappuccino and croissant. Cappuccino consists of milk and coffee; its peculiarity lies in its foams – obtained by whipping milk and coffee – that has to be thick on the palate. As for croissants, they can be either plain or stuffed with jam or cream. Milk and coffee with a cake called “ciambellone”: this is a very simple cake to prepare. Its ingredients are: flour, sugar, butter, milk and eggs; it is possible to stuff it with cocoa, powdered sugar or dried fruit. “Crostata” is another typical cake: its ingredients are: butter, flour and eggs for the “pastafrolla” (pastry). It is more friable than “ciambellone”, which is softer. It can be stuffed with jam of all tastes or Nutella, as well.
