Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan opened the new Istanbul Airport, a major public-works project that is part of his 15-year building spree.
Costing \$11.7 billion, the new airport is likely to be one of the world's busiest when it is fully operational.
The new airport is expected to serve more than 100 airline companies and reach over 300 destinations, according to IGA.
The developer estimates that the airport will serve 90 million passengers in the first phase of construction, which was completed this week, and up to 200 million across three terminals once the fourth phase is completed between 2025 and 2027.

The value of Bitcoin has fallen below \$5,000 (£3,889) for the first time since October 2017.
The fall brought the total value of all Bitcoin in existence to below \$87bn.
On Thursday, 15 November, Bitcoin Cash - an offshoot of Bitcoin - split into two different cryptocurrencies, which are now in competition with each other.
And some observers have blamed this for creating turmoil in the crypto-currency markets, with many of the digital assets experiencing falls.
Bitcoin exchange Kraken said in a blog post that it regarded one of the two new Bitcoin Cash crypto-currencies - Bitcoin SV - as "an extremely risky investment".
Bitcoin is a notoriously volatile crypto-currency.
At its peak, in November 2017, it briefly hit \$19,783 - which means the price has fallen by about 75%.

Every year on 29th October, many people in Turkey celebrate Republic Day by attending performances and participating in traditional processions with flags and musical bands. The Turkish Republic's founder Mustafa Kemal Atatürk proclaimed Republic Day as Turkey's most important holiday. Many people go to local stadiums on October 29 to watch performances dedicated to Republic Day in Turkey. Such performances usually consist of theater sketches, poetry readings and traditional Turkish dances. Many school children participate in school performances for parents and teachers. Parades may take place in some cities and politicians may give public speeches on this day.

ONE EUROPE ONE ASIA

ASIA- JAPAN

It is thought that the first people of Japan were migrants from East Asia and South Pacific Islands. The ancestors of the Japanese people are supposed to be the same race people who gained the upper hand over warrior tribes and clans in the 3rd and 4th centuries after the so-called Yamato Race. In Japan was seen Confucian Religions and Buddhism Religions. These religions came to Japan in 538 through India, China and Korea. The country's first and permanent government center was established in Nara at the beginning of the 8th century. This empire reigned between 710 and 784.

In 794 a government center was established in Kyoto. This empire continued until 1192 and Kyoto became capital. Between 1553 and 1538, short-term governments were seen in 16 century Europeans entered the territory of Japan. In this process, Christianity was intended to spread, but Japan thought it would be harmful for its own people. Therefore, all foreigners were forbidden to enter the country except the Dutch and Chinese merchants.

In 1853, the American Komodor Matthew C. Peter entered Tokyo with four ships and navy. The following year he came again and convinced Japan to sign the agreement of friendship and the agreement was signed. Thanks to the Emperor Meiji, many things in the West were quickly produced in Japan. After Japan, Japan and China War, it declared its independence and reached its present state of welfare.

EUROPE: ITALY

Before the Romans, many tribes from Europe and Asia lived in Italy. In the 1st century BC, during the reign of Julius Caesar, the borders of the Roman Empire expanded rapidly. The Roman Empire was the basis for the development of Western civilizations, which ruled the vast lands from Britain to Iran until it was divided into the Eastern and Western Empires after 395 BC.

The empire, which influences the western world in every sense, is considered one of the greatest empires in the history of the world. As a result of the currents of barbarian tribes in the Middle Ages, the Roman Empire was first divided into two as west and east. Italy, which was divided into small kingdoms after the fall of the Western Roman Empire, was home to the Renaissance period, which was regarded as one of the milestones of European Civilization History. Italy, dominated by the Holy Roman Empire, has been the dominant power of Europe for many years.

As a result of numerous wars that took place in the 19th century due to the rising nationalist movement in Europe, Italy, which provided its national unity in 1871, defined itself as the Republic in 1948.

KEBAB

INGREDIENTS

- 1 lb lean ground mutton
- 50 gr fat from lamb tail, finely chopped
- 1 tsp crushed red pepper
- ½ tsp black pepper
- ½ tsp cumin
- 1 tsp salt to taste
- Skewers or chop sticks

DIRECTION: Leave the crushed red pepper in ½ cup of water for about 2-3 hours, to get them softened. Then drain. Mix all the ingredients with your hands. Grab a fist size mixture and skewer it. Squeeze it on the skewer until it gets smooth and lengthens to acquire the shape shown in the picture. Cook on a grill or oven. You can grill some vegetables as well on the side. Refrigerate the skewered Adana Kebabs overnight to get a better flavor. Serve with warm pita bread and Side Salad for Kebabs. ENJOY.

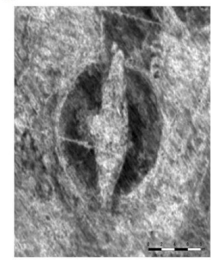

STORY BEHIND

Banksy: "There is Always Hope"

On the surface of this Banksy image, there is an obvious meaning stated by the text in the piece: "There is Always Hope" and as Banksy has said before, it is important for people to understand quickly because a lot of his work is only seen as a glance out of a car and therefore it needs to be understood immediately or it needs to draw the viewer to have a closer look.

However, many of Banksy's pieces have meanings or jokes behind the meaning, and in this piece there appears to be a juxtaposition between the words and the image, because although the words state "There is Always Hope" the balloon just out of reach of the little girl appears to symbolise peace, happiness, innocence and dreams and yet it is not reachable by the girl who the viewer would assume would represent themselves. The assumption is that this image shows a love lost or innocence of childhood lost, and if it weren't for the words on the Wall there would be no question, however, the caption leaves the audience questioning what the real meaning of the image is, and wondering if the girl had released the balloon or trying to retrieve it.

Banksy buffed the Wall underneath the little girl in order to make a stark contrast between the dark tones of her from and the bright red balloon, but left the Wall under his words dirty, writing in a bright white. This could symbolise hope, showing that hope surrounds this innocent child, perhaps hoping for the love and dreams symbolised as the balloon, and then further along, perhaps the distance and the natural line on the wall between the child and the text represents time passing, in the darkest part of the Wall, there is always hope.

Banksy's piece leaves the viewer with a positive feeling because of the words on the wall, despite how one might interpret the image accompanying it. Although simple, it is an image that seems to draw the viewer in again and again. There is a timeless quality to There is Always Hope, that seems to evoke our basic human needs and desires of love and hope, and this seems to be a universal feeling as the piece has been preserved behind perspex, as a piece of Art.
