SCIENTISTS FIND THE WAY TO INFORMATION TO THE BRAIN

Scientists say it will be easy to upload information to the brain just like Matrix. "It will be as easy as falling asleep", they said. The researchers claim that they can transfer the information directly to the human brain in a very short time and they can teach people new skills in a short time. They define this as the first steps of a software that can instantly learn the Matrix style fast and new information. As most of us remember the famous Neo character of Matrix was able to do Kung Fu in seconds after it was loaded.

The studies were conducted by the HRL Laboratory in California, USA. HRL Lab researchers in central California have already taken the first steps to learn through installation, even though they haven't reached software as advanced as Matrix. Later in the research, the signals of a trained pilot were studied on the brain and the information obtained was transferred to the novice pilot candidates. The participants were divided into two groups. Then on the head on both groups put electron headpiece and they were told that they would be transferred information to their brains. However the developed technique was applied to only one of these groups and thus the placebo effect of the study was observed. These candidates were also learning to pilot in a flight simulator. As a result of this research, it was seen that information provided to novice pilot candidates benefited 33% better learning.

SCIENTIFIC RESEARCHES

Dr. Matthew Philips states that the system they developed is the first of its kind and this is defined as a brain stimulation system. This method is actually developed 4000 years ago. The ancient Egyptians used electric fish to stimulate and relieve pain. Even Benjamin Franklin is known to apply current to himself. However, in the early 2000s, meticulous scientific research of these methods began and aimed to target and personalize this research in the most effective way possible. All these developments may sound like science fiction films to us. But behind this new method there is a great scientific basis. When you learn new information, your brain will change physically. In this process called neuroplasticity, connections are created and strengthened. It seems that certain functions, such as speech and memory in the brain, are located in some paths of the brain. Dr. Matthews says this new method will be used in certain things, such as driving, preparing for an exam or learning a language.

Digital TRAVEL Mountain of Gods

"The Commagene Kingdom"



The eighth wonder of the world. Charming sculptures, unique landscapes.....

The Mount Nemrut Tumuluses is in Kahta county which is 86 km east of Adiyaman city. The Mount Nemrut is one of the highest peaks of the Mesopotamia, and its summit at **2,206 metres** above the sea level contains the tomb of King Antiochus I of Commagene, commissioned by himself. The gigantic statues of gods, each weighing 6 tons and 10 metres tall, indicate what kind of super-human effort was spent on the construction of the tomb. This attempt to gather all the known gods on Mount Nemrut can be seen on the eastern and western terraces of the mount. On the eastern terrace of Mount Nemrut, there is a row of five colossal limestone statues. An identical row of statues can be found on the western terrace. These seated statues face outwards from the tumulus, and are flanked by a pair of guardian animal statues - a lion on one end and an eagle on the other.

Mount Nemrut is one of the best places in the world to watch rising Sun. Millions of tourists from different countries come Mount Nemrut to watch rising Sun every year.

One Day In Mount Nemrut

If you go at night, you can do camping. There are suitable places to stay in tents. If you don't want to stay in a tent, there is a hotel, too. Before the sun rising, you must arrive the peak of the mount. At the peak there are some places for people made of stones to sit and watch rising Sun. Rising of Sun continues nearly one hour step by step. After the Sun rises you can go to the statues and you can observe them. There is an interesting thing that there are the same statues in the east side and in the west side of the mount. Finally you can watch the setting of the Sun in the east side. And then you can leave there. Do not miss the chance to see sunrise and sunset at Mount Nemrut and ENJOY IT.
