OUR CITY - Nettuno

Nettuno is a city overlooking the Tyrrenian sea and, alongside Anzio, it was known as the ancient city of "Antium", a termal area and holiday resort for the ancient Romans.





Later on, from the Middle Ages to the
Unification of Italy, Nettuno became feud of
several noble families in Lazio.
It was later reunited under a local
administration during the Second World War.

Nettuno still retains its historical identity. The Medieval Borough is the city's symbol, with its towers and little squares dating back to the 14th century.



USES & CUSTOMS

The most important <u>holiday</u> is the "Feast of the Madonna", celebrated the 1st Saturday of May. According to tradition, a procession is expected where, children dress up as angels, and girls with a traditional prioress costume (middle ages dresses).





Typical <u>dishes</u> from Nettuno are among the most diverse, such as ricotta pie and some traditional Roman dishes as "Carbonara" and "Amatriciana"

SCHOOL (History)

We attend <u>ITIS Trafelli high school</u> (State Technical and Industrial Institute) founded by Luigi Trafelli, who lived in the 10th century.

He had a degree in <u>Maths and Physics</u> and invented a new type of unipolar direct current dynamo. He taught in many universities, also abroad, and wrote a philosophical treatise in his last years.



SCHOOL (Addresses)

Our school comprises of a <u>Scientific Lyceum</u> and a Technological Institute, which specializes in three different courses:

- Mechanics and Mechatronics
- Electronics and Electro technical
- □ Informatics and telecommunications.
